Janat is an 11 year old peasant girl living with her single mother. Janat and her family were practicing Muslims, when we reached out to her family she received Christ. She is now on the worship team at school and is currently in primary level five. Janat has been one of the top five students in her class. With her visual impairment deteriorating this year it has affected her schoolwork and her self esteem. We took her to Mengo Hospital to check her eyes, where optometrist performed an eye exam. She has been diagnosed with blindness in one of her eyes and poor vision and eye strain in the other caused by Dx Myopia with Amblyopia Glaucoma. After further consultation with the optometrist, surgery and a replacement of the Pseudophakia (Lens). This will need to be done as soon as possible before she loses her eye sight completely. The surgery is already scheduled for the 1st week of June. By faith we are believing for the funds to pay for this procedure.

After further consultation with the optometrist, they would like to perform surgery and a replacement of the Pseudophakia (Lens) in both eyes. After the surgery they will do what is called eye patching where he will be given glasses to help him see clearly again.
