This is Kijja Twalaha. He comes from a very strong Muslim family. When his mother brought him to school, they were even raising him to be a Shekhe (preacher in the mosque)/ The boy never wanted to be in a Christian school because all his life he had been in Arabic Muslim schools, and he only knew how to read the Quran. He told his mother Yjisy that he can't be in a community where they talk about Jesus. But the Lord we serve is a mighty God. God has changed this boy's life in a period of 4 months. His fellow students nicknamed him "apostle" because of the Love he has for Jesus. He has a talent for worshiping and every Friday when the entire school comes together for Devotion, he is always among the first students to gather for prayer. We glorify God for opening this boy's spiritual eyes to see the light!



This is Kibazo Rahim, and he is 12 years old. He is also from a very strong Muslim family and has been at Heritage of Faith for 2 years. When he first joined the school, he used to dodge prayer by telling us that his grandfather had taught him only to worship Allah and Muhammad, so he could not worship Jesus. We faced a hard time with this boy because he would even tell the teachers that he didn't want to study at Heritage due to this conflict. Today, Kibazo is a follower of Christ; he even told his mom that he wants to become a gospel singer for the Lord. He gave his life to Jesus, and now he is also among the worship team at school.
