### UPCOMING PROJECT: SOLAR PANELS

*We are standing in faith and believing God! As the Scripture says, "Faith does not make things easy, it makes them possible." — Luke 1:37*

*We are trusting God for the installation of solar panels at the schools, which will be a tremendous blessing for us. Currently, we barely have electricity in the village. Yet we have computers, a photocopier, phones, and most importantly, students who need light for their studies. Our 7th-grade class studies until 9 PM, and the lack of reliable lighting affects both their learning and our ability to use the copy machine for school materials. The solar panels will cost, \$9K, and every seed counts!*
